Bar Staff:

Bartenders (must be 21): Serve beer and mixed drinks to visitors

Bar Runner (must be 19 or older): Monitor and supply bar

Dis/ability Knowledge:

Front Gate (admissions): Collect admission fees and monitor re-entry.

Vendor Registration Table: Direct vendors to their tents.

Runner (Street Fair): Assist Vendor Coordinator and vendors.

Arts Committee: Help provide year round cultural activities that support the community.
